**Students boarded the Navy Vessel,**

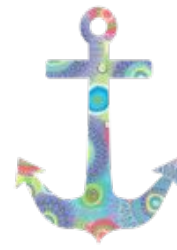

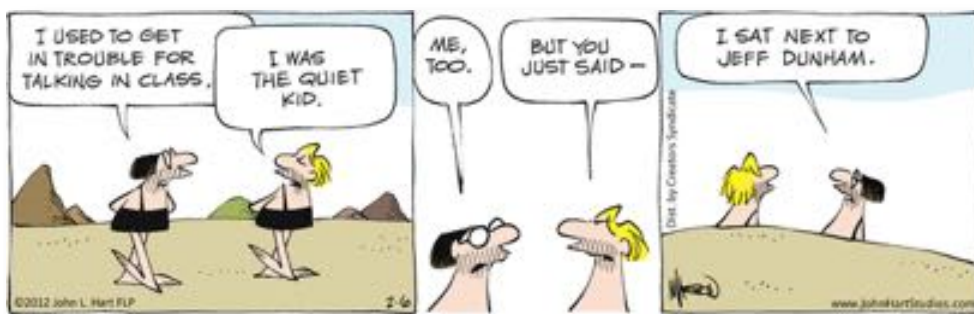
