where you will be able to learn all there is to know about subject choices, qualifications, university exemption and avenues of study.

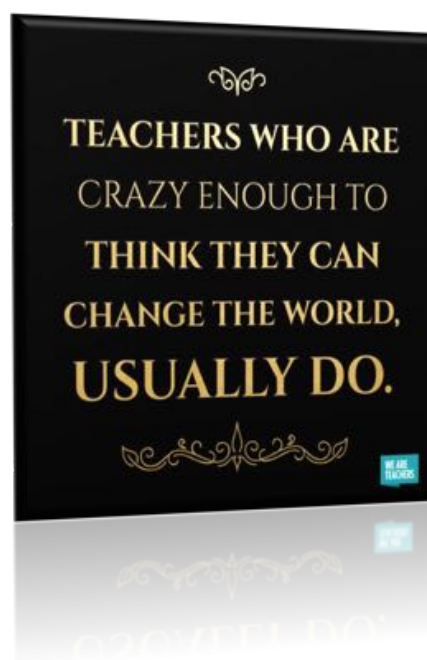
ISWB Swayed by Affies

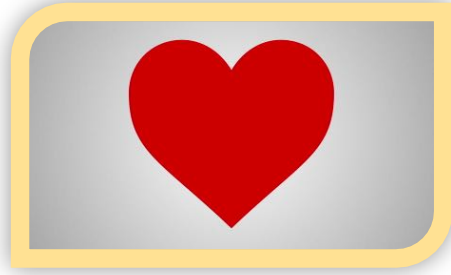

The Blood Donation Project

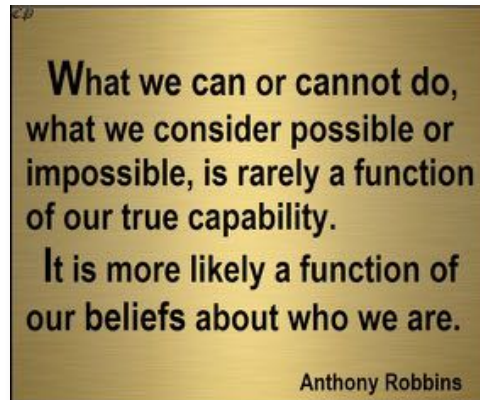

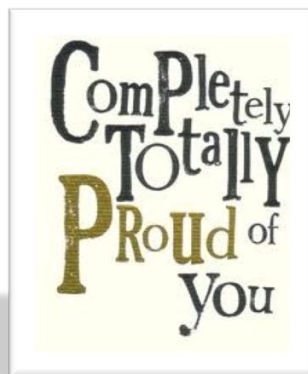
