They are renowned for their courage, elegance and pride.

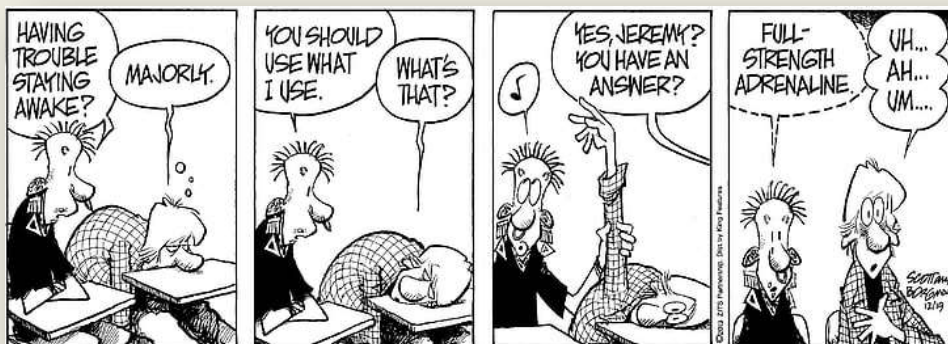
A Namib sand dune with a *Welwitschia mirabilis* on the foreground.

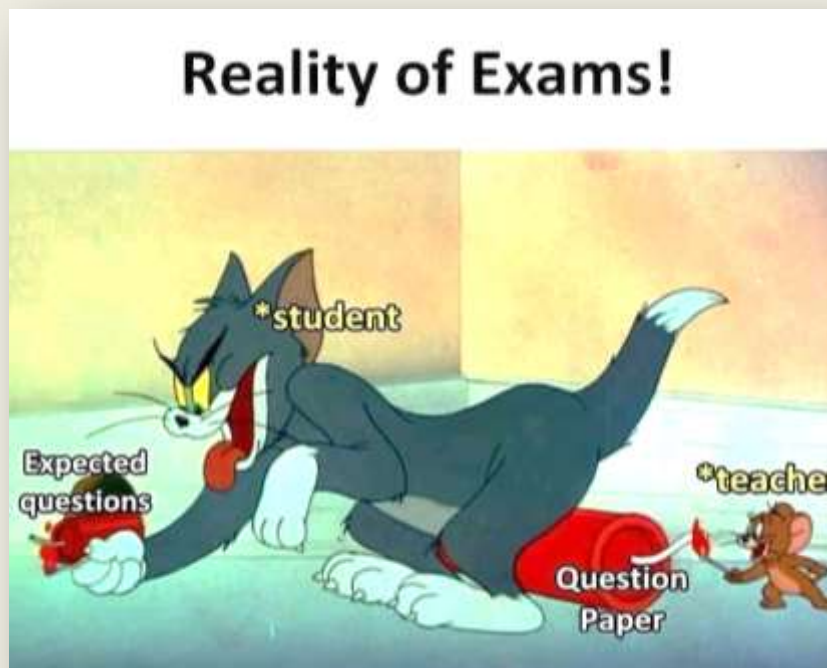
